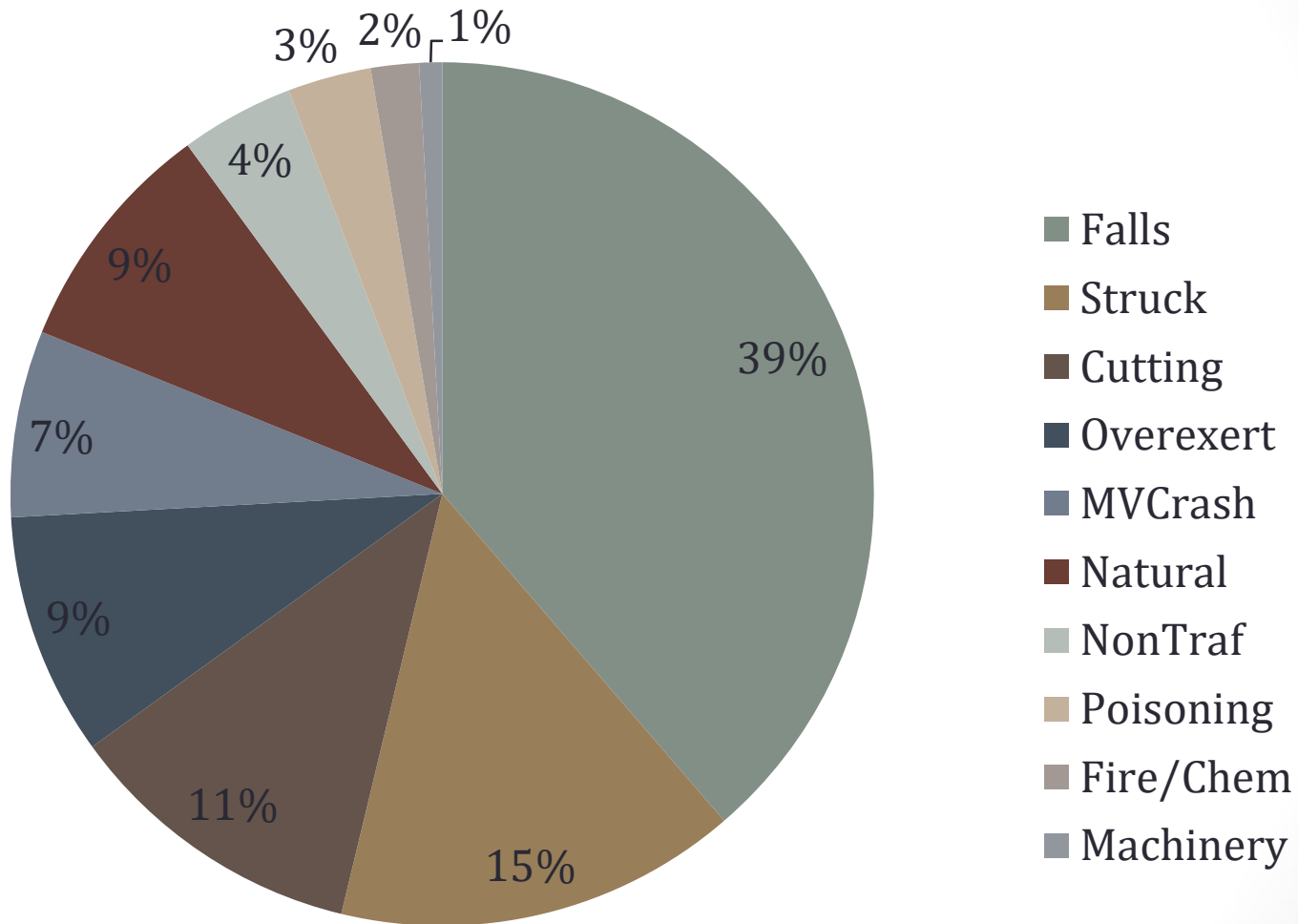

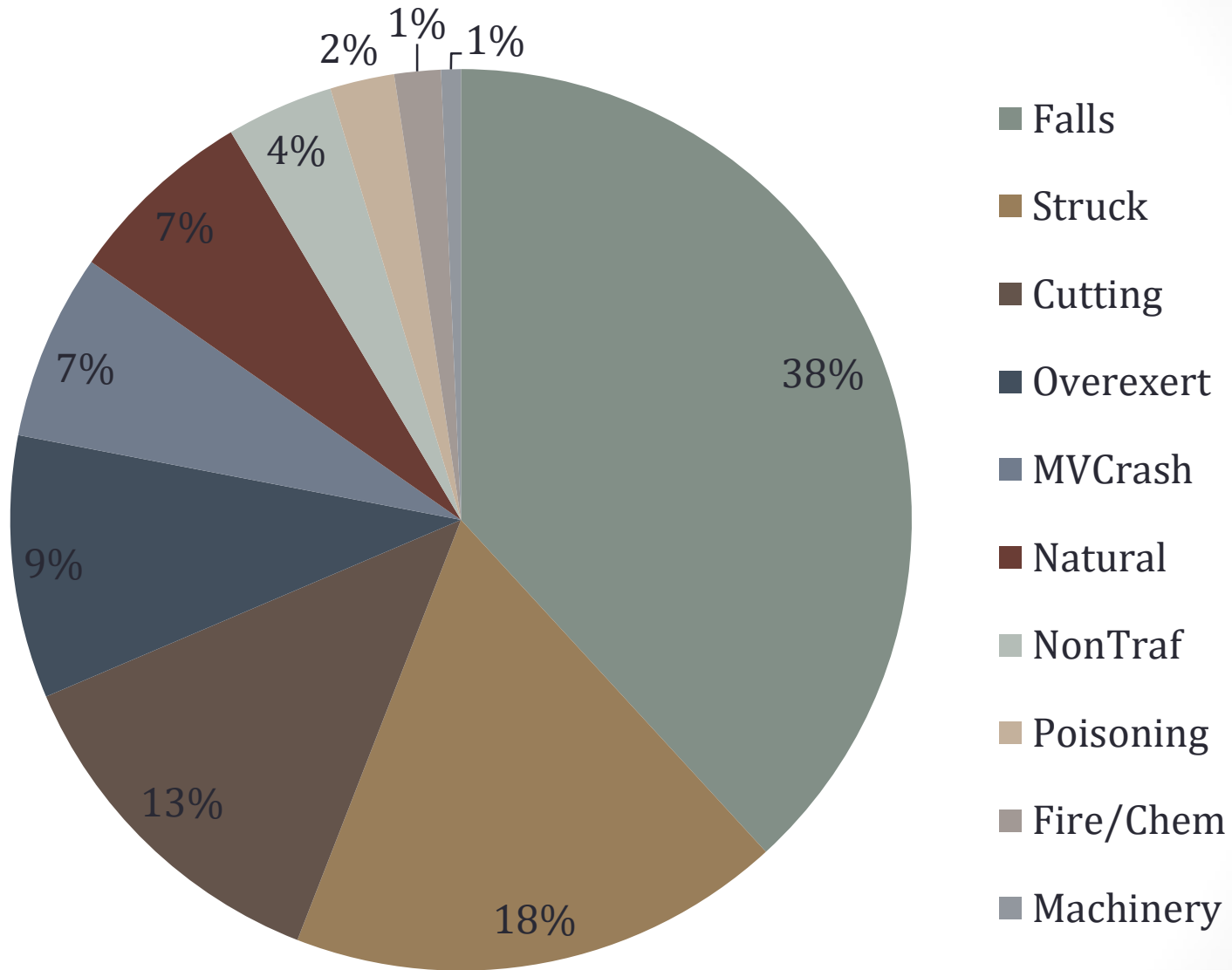

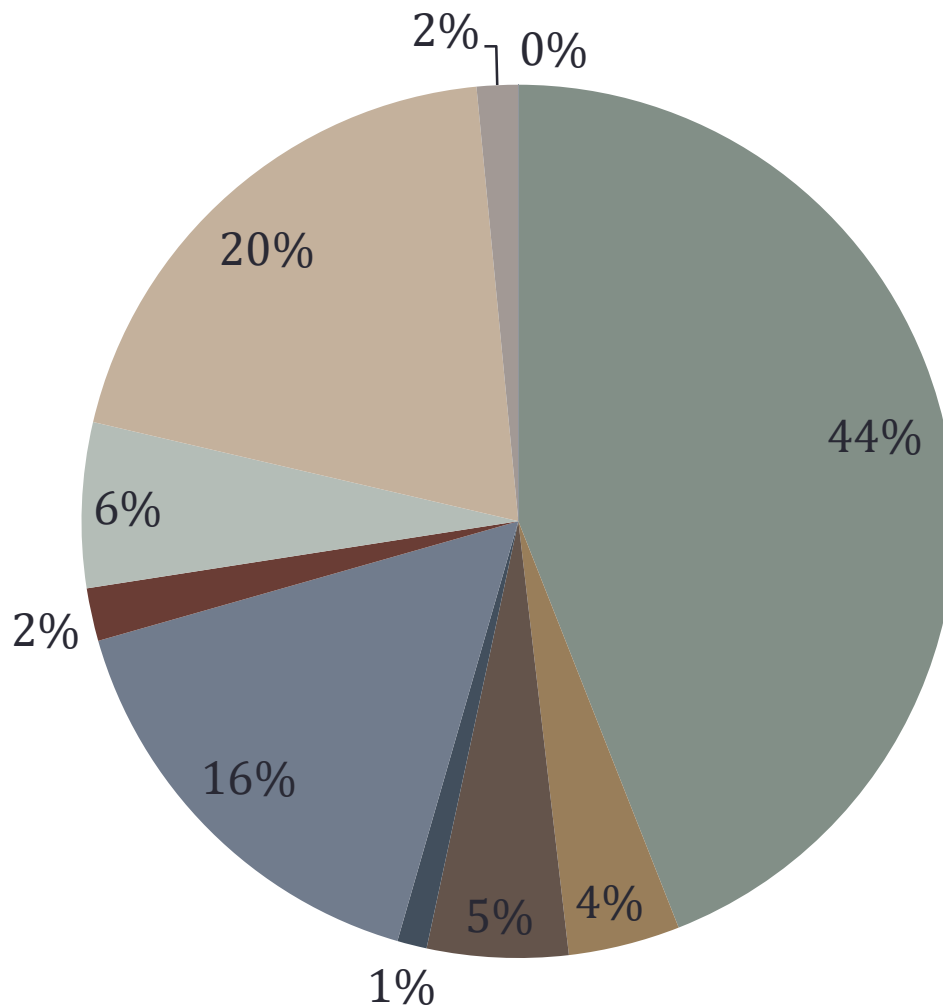

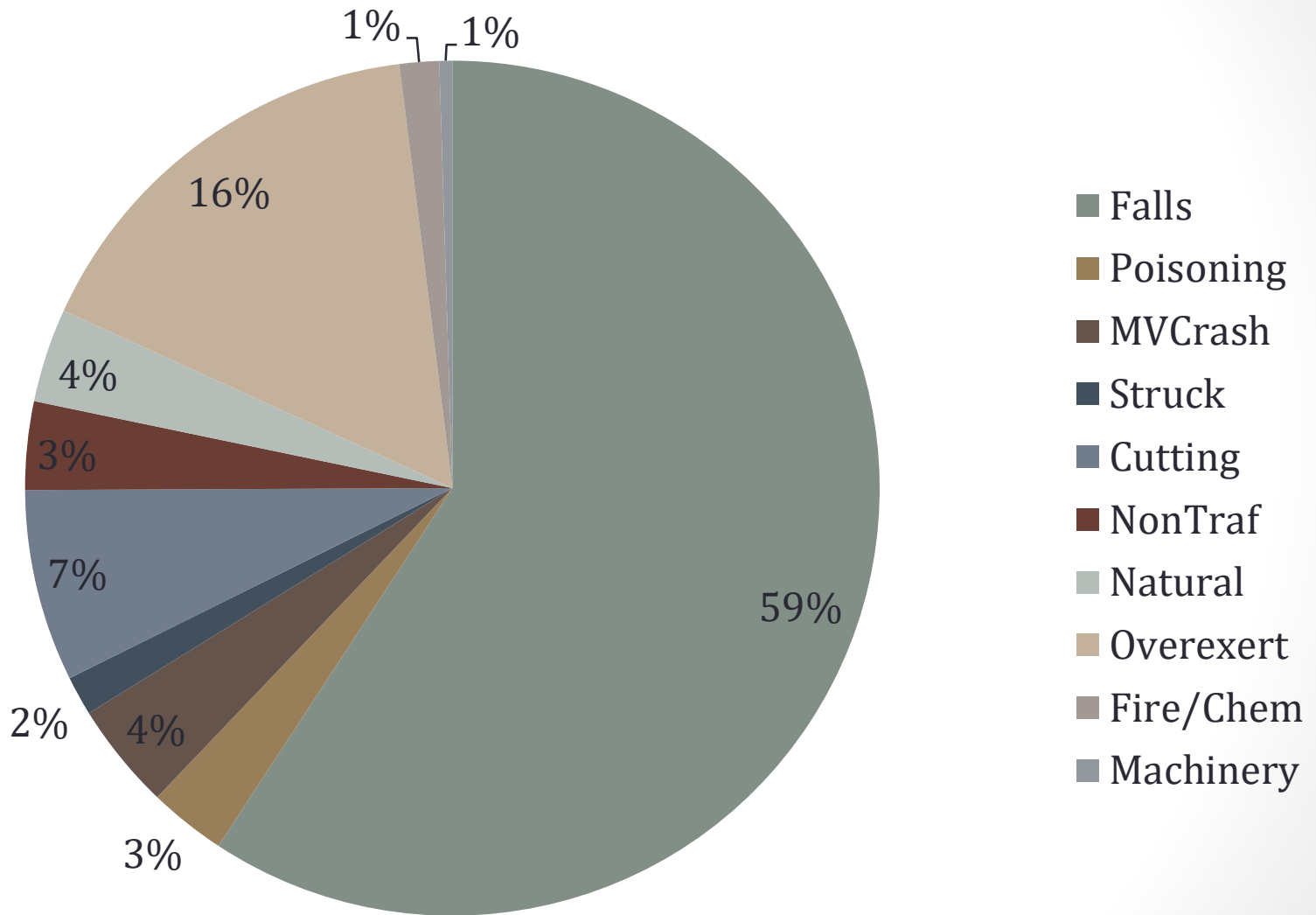
2009 -2013 Injury Hospitalization

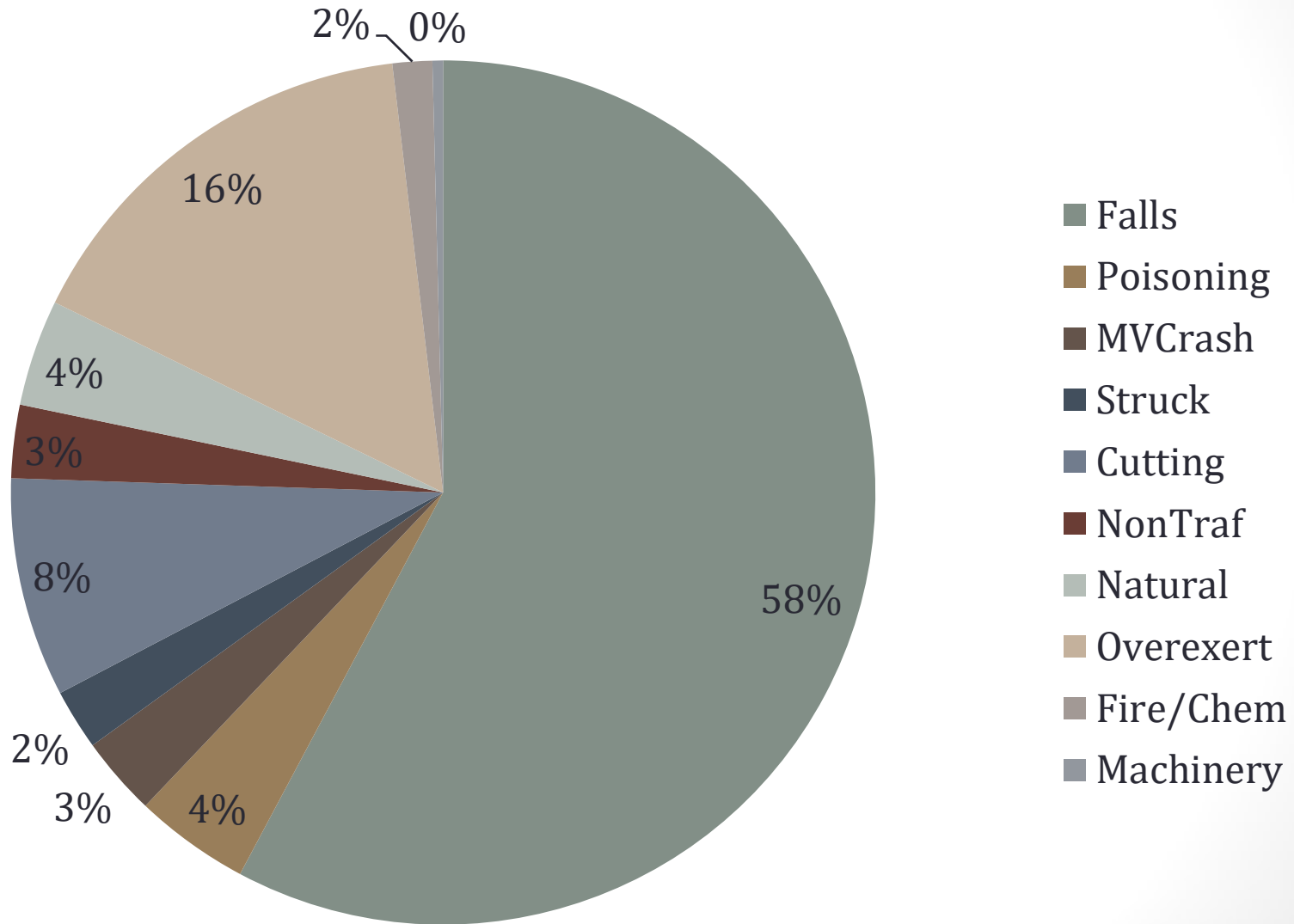

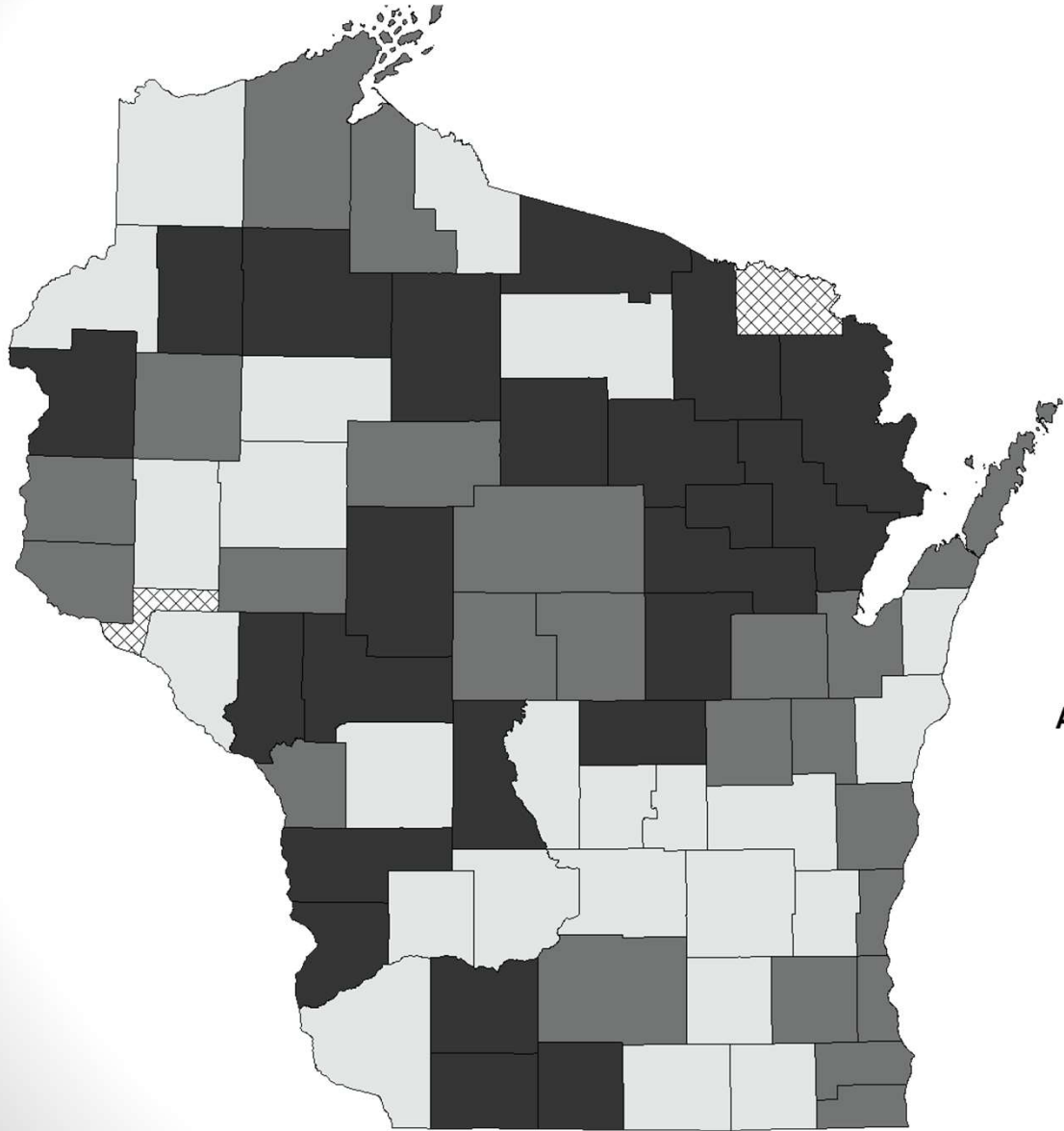

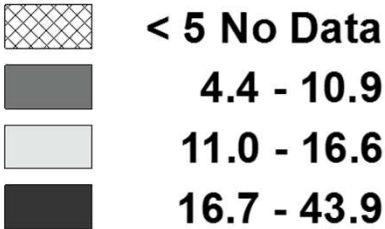


2009-2013 Age-Adjusted Mortality Rate with Motor Vehicle Crash Listed as the Primary Cause of Death

Wisconsin Seatbelt Use

According to the BRFSS....

92% of Wisconsin Adults report they always or nearly always wear a seatbelt

92% of Wisconsin students in grades 9-12 reported most of the time or always wear a seat belt when riding in a car driven by someone else

41.4% of United States students

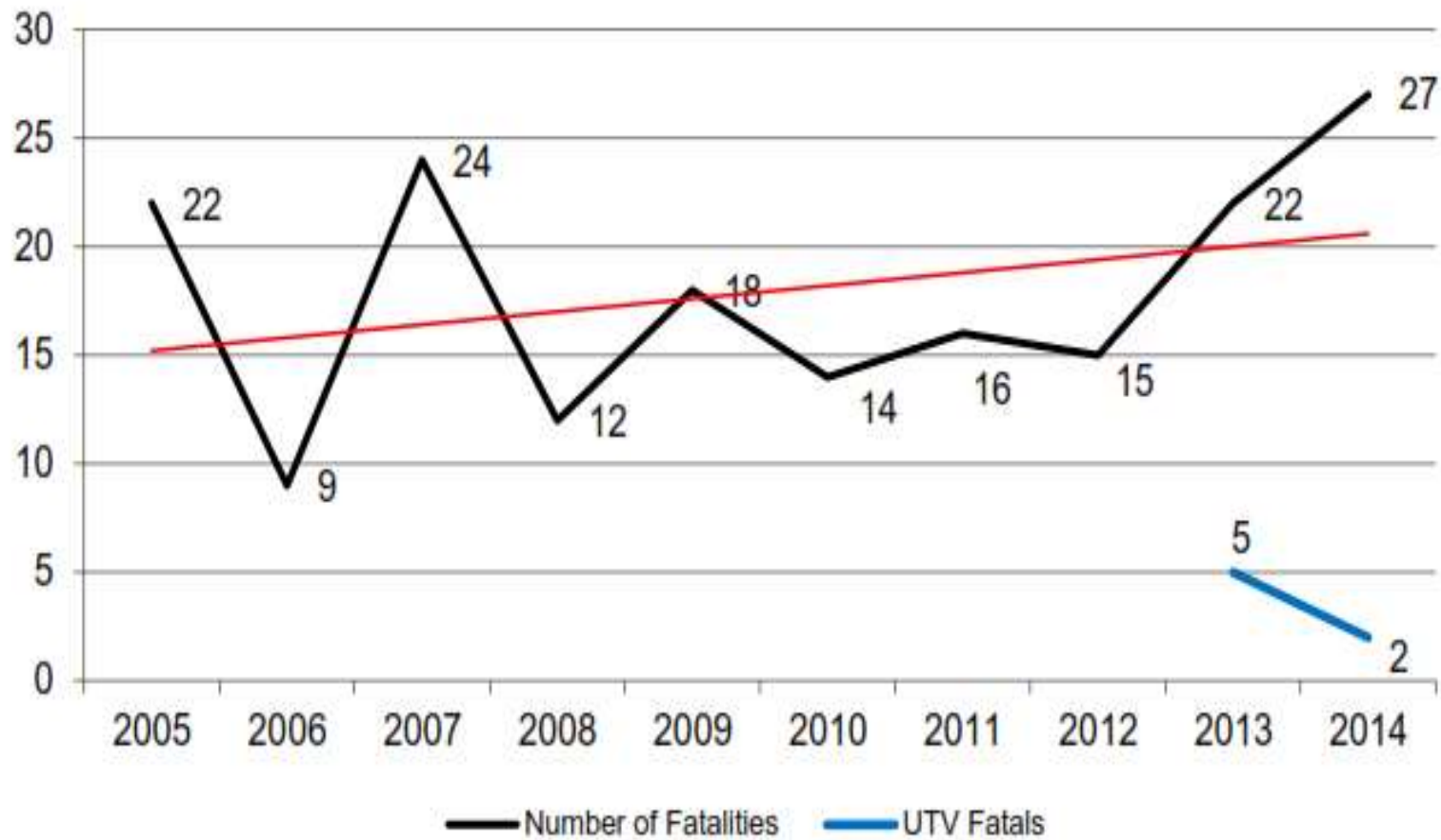
1994-2013 Number of Deaths to County Residents with Homicide Listed as the Primary Cause of Death

14 Forest County residents had Homicide listed as the primary cause of death. An Average of 0.7 per year.

7 Oneida County residents had Homicide listed as the primary cause of death. An Average of 0.35 per year.

6 Vilas County residents had Homicide listed as the primary cause of death. An Average of less than 0.3 per year.

Wisconsin ATV Fatalities



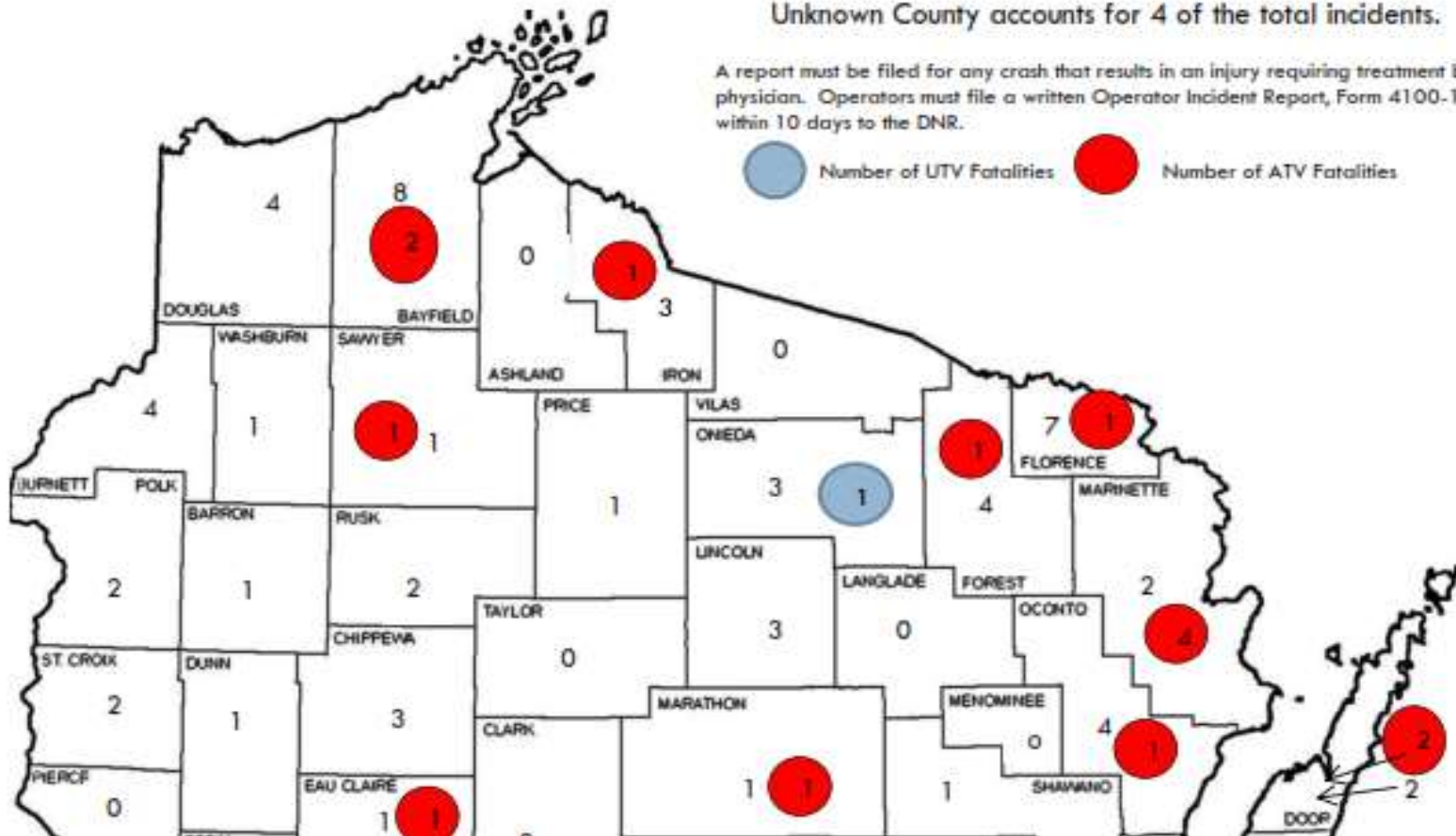
ATV – 2014 Total Injury Incidents reported to Law Enforcement

Total Incidents = 275; ATV Total = 263; UTV Total = 12

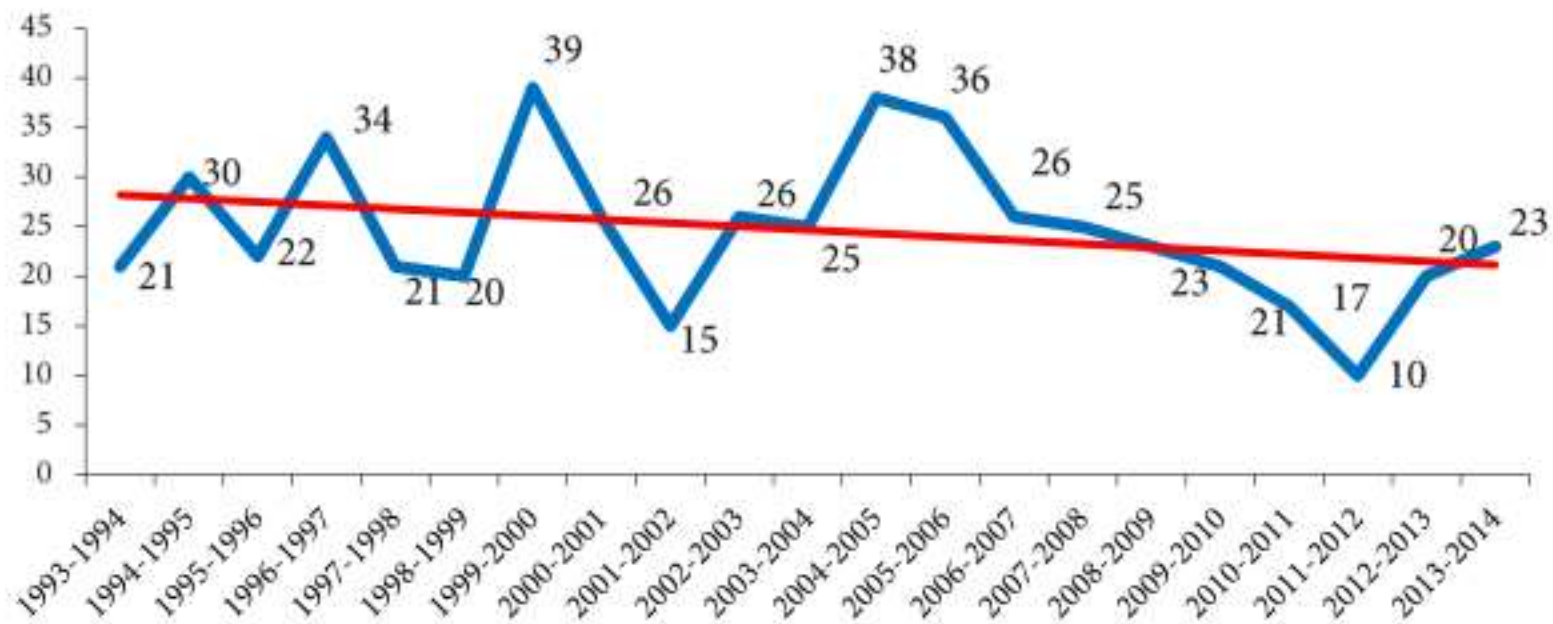
Unknown County accounts for 4 of the total incidents.

A report must be filed for any crash that results in an injury requiring treatment by a physician. Operators must file a written Operator Incident Report, Form 4100-174 within 10 days to the DNR.

Wisconsin Snowmobile Fatalities

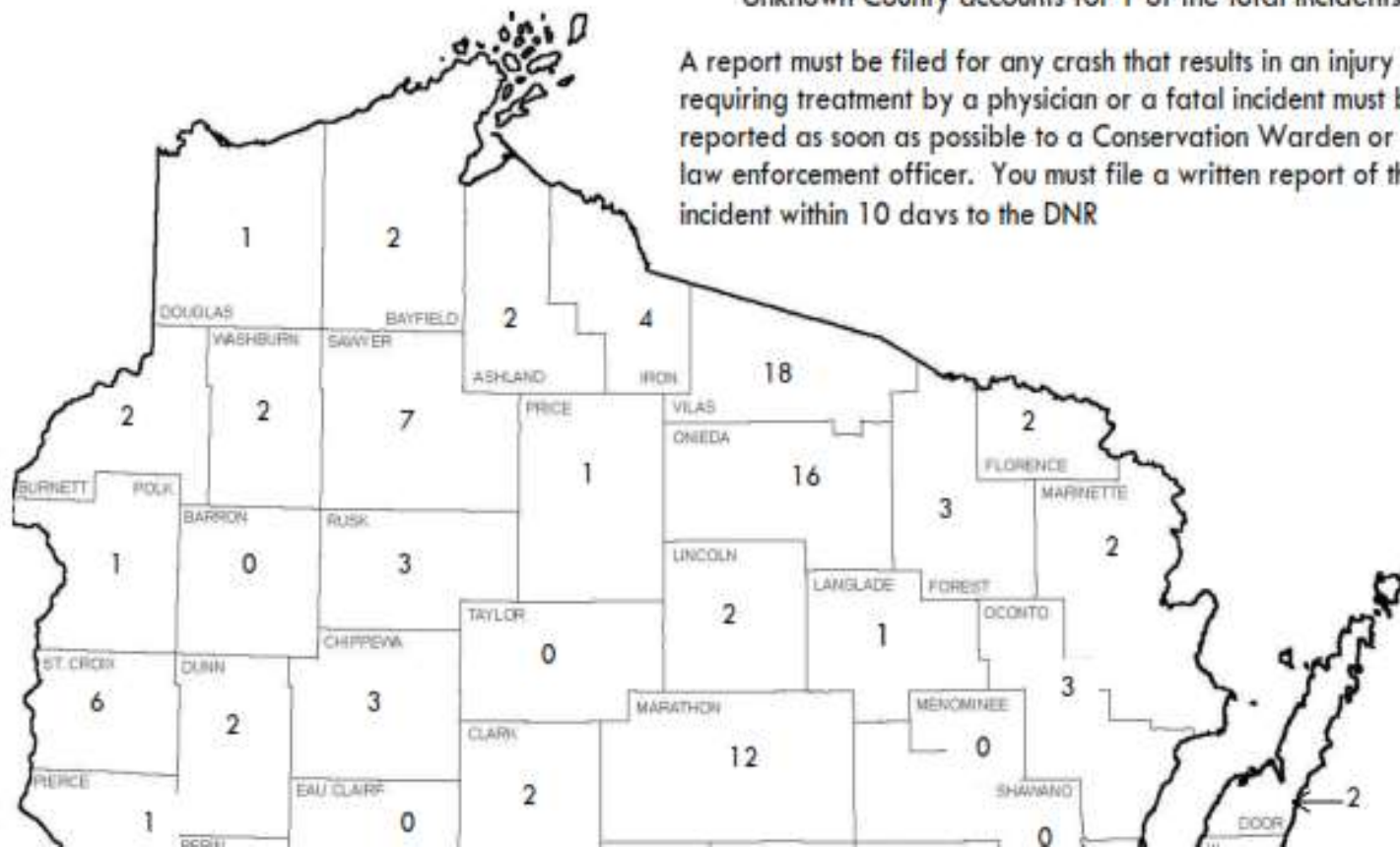


Snowmobile – 2013-2014 Total Injury Incidents Reported to Law Enforcement

Total Incidents = 181

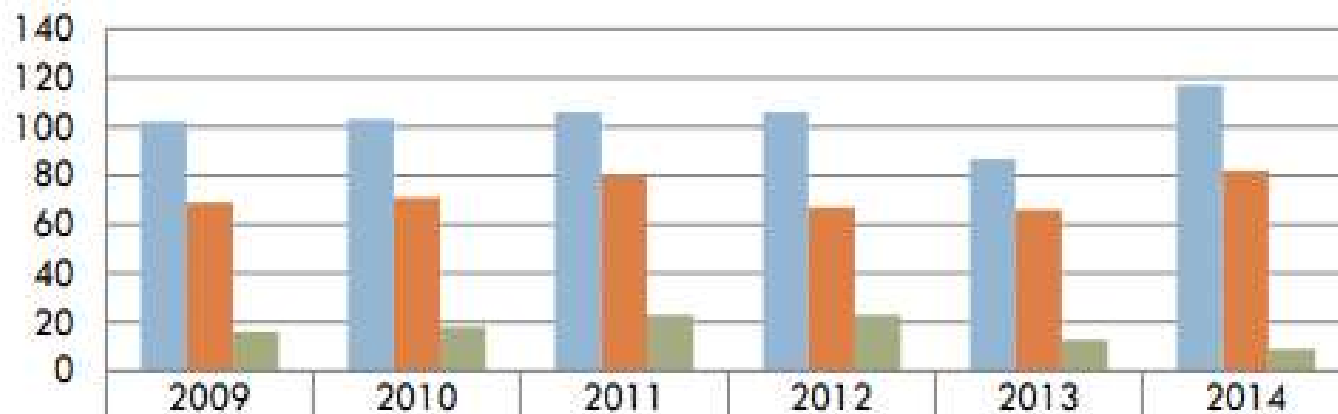
Unknown County accounts for 1 of the total incidents.

A report must be filed for any crash that results in an injury requiring treatment by a physician or a fatal incident must be reported as soon as possible to a Conservation Warden or other law enforcement officer. You must file a written report of the incident within 10 days to the DNR
