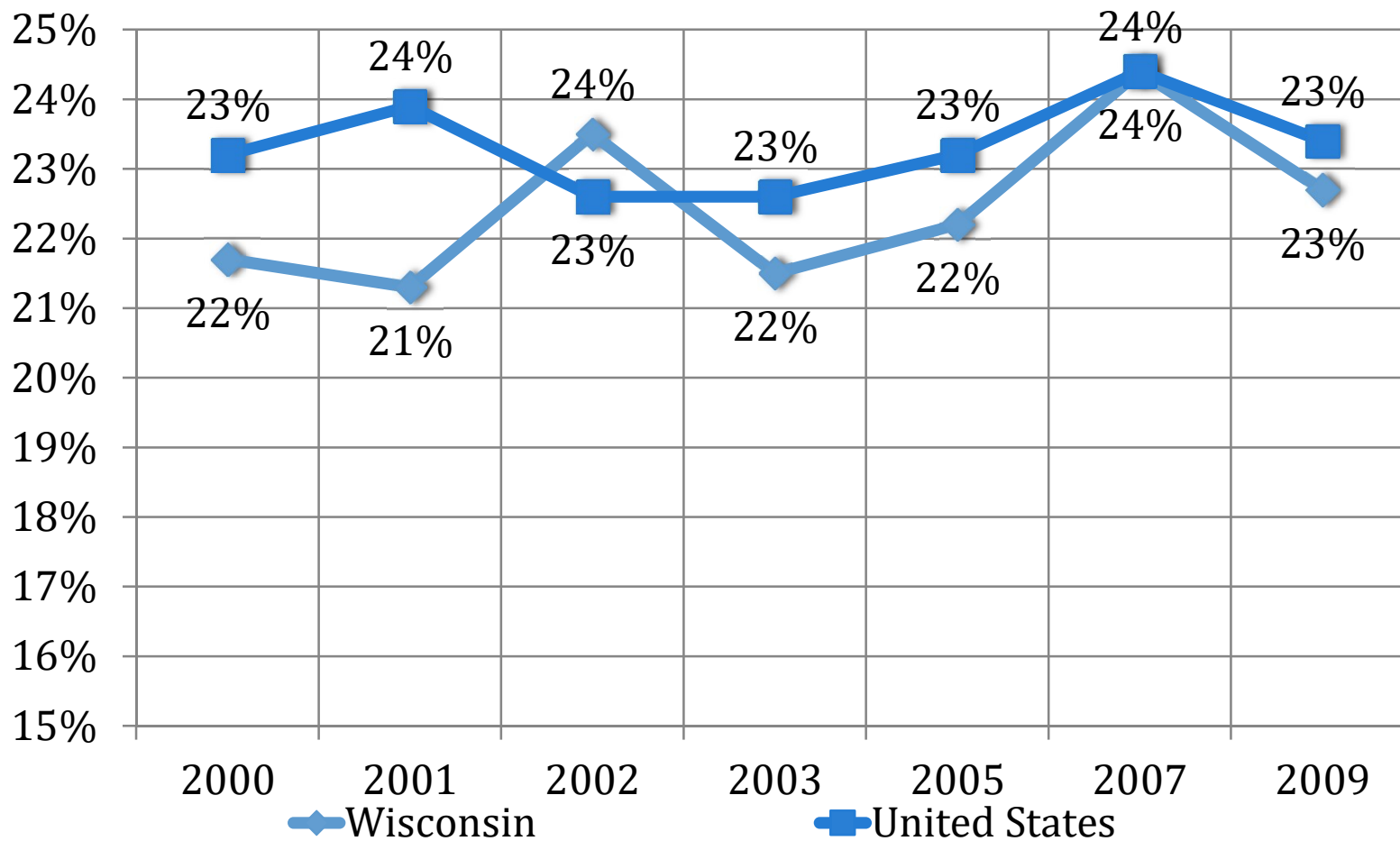

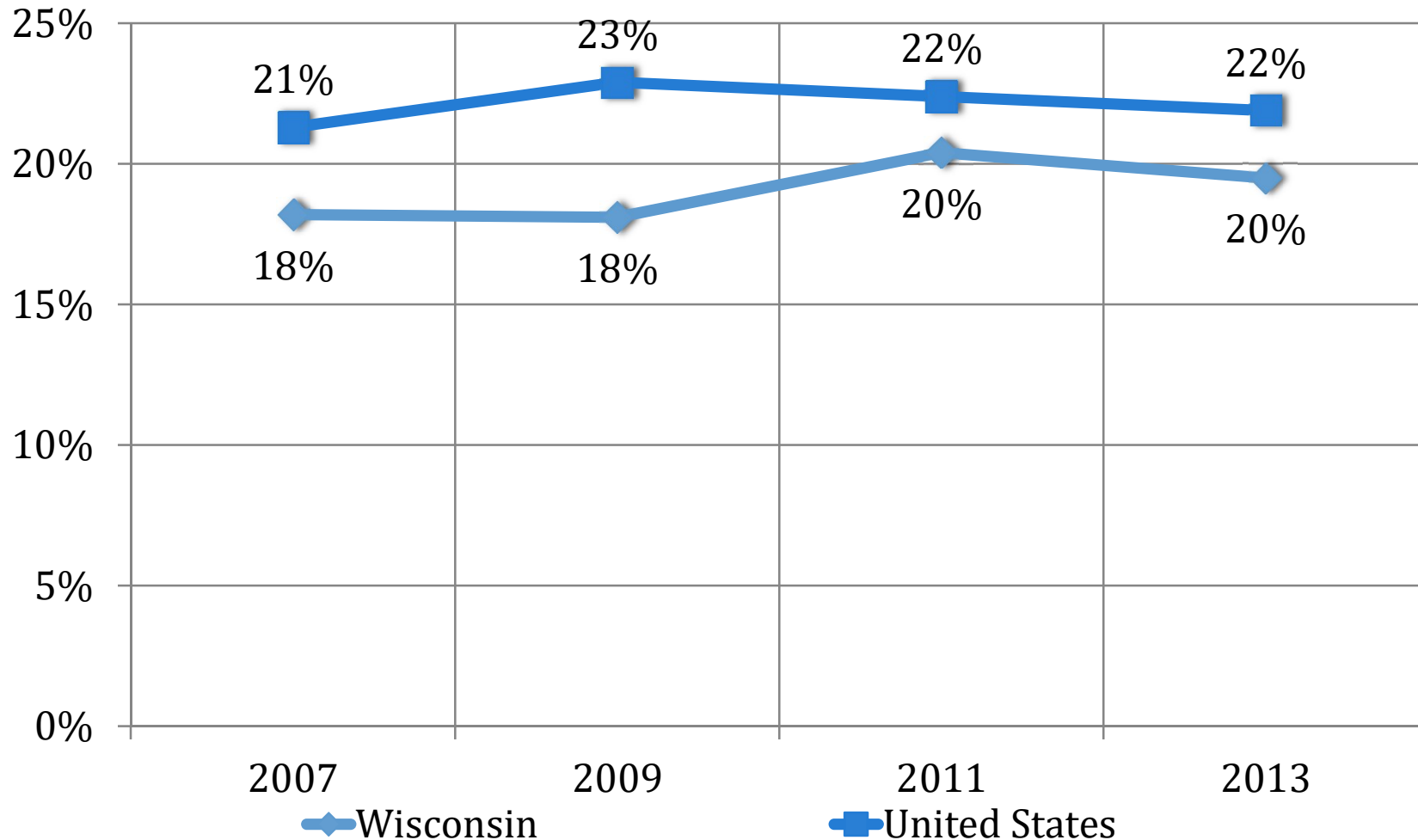

Percentage of adults who have consumed fruits and vegetables five or more times per day



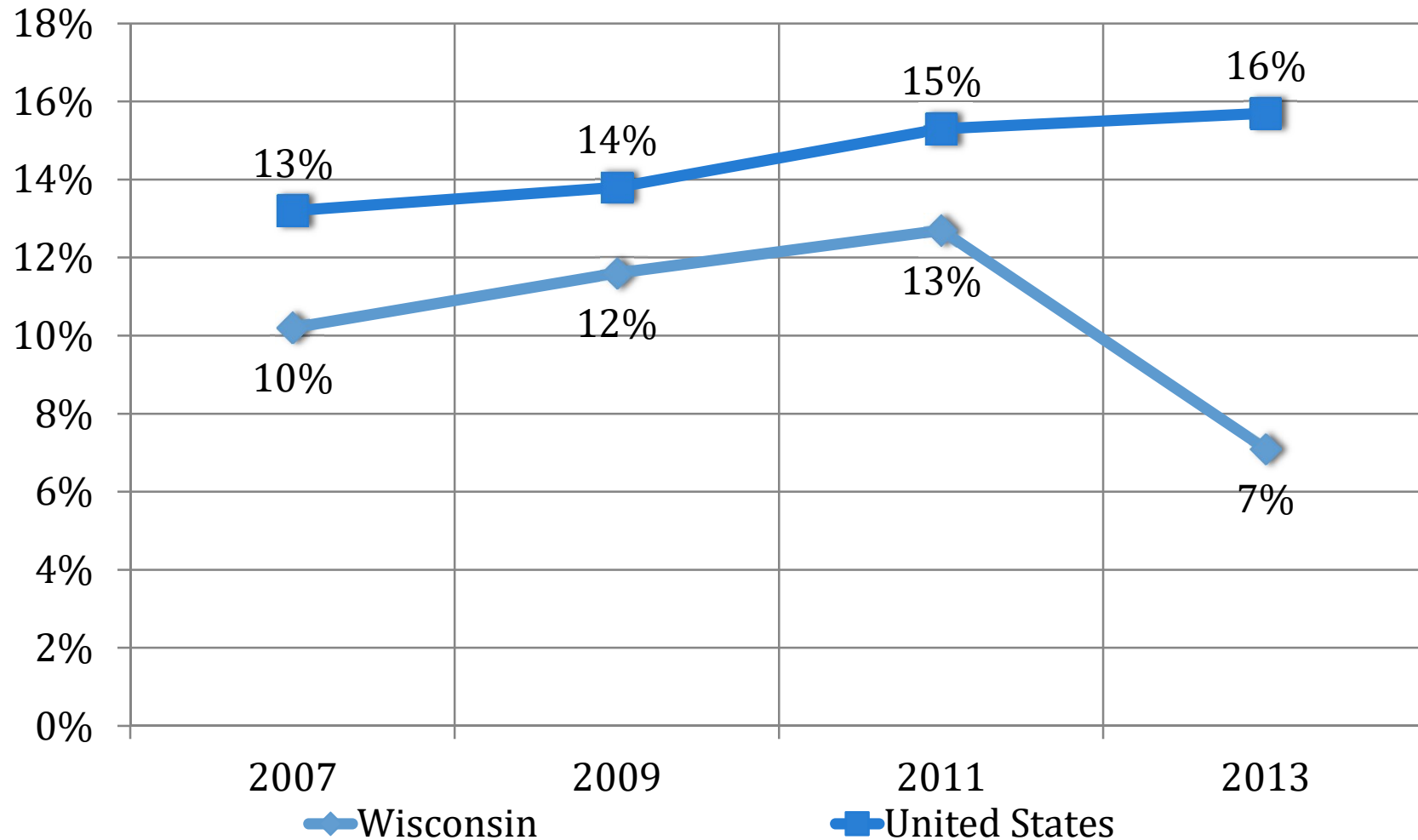

Percentage of students in grades 9-12 who reported eating fruit or drinking 100 % fruit juices three or more times per day during the 7 days before the survey



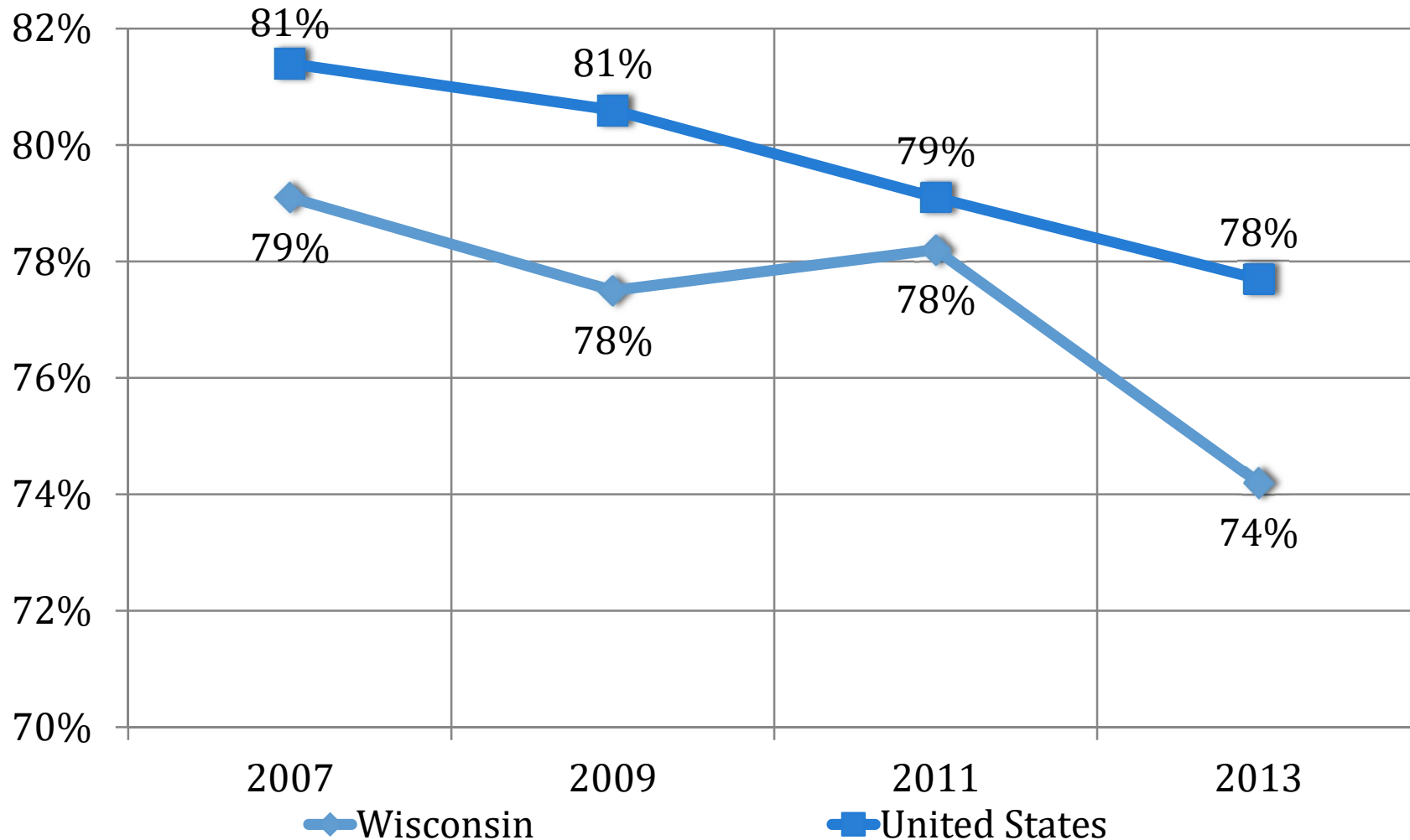

Percentage of students in grades 9-12 who reported eating vegetables three or more times per day during the 7 days before the survey



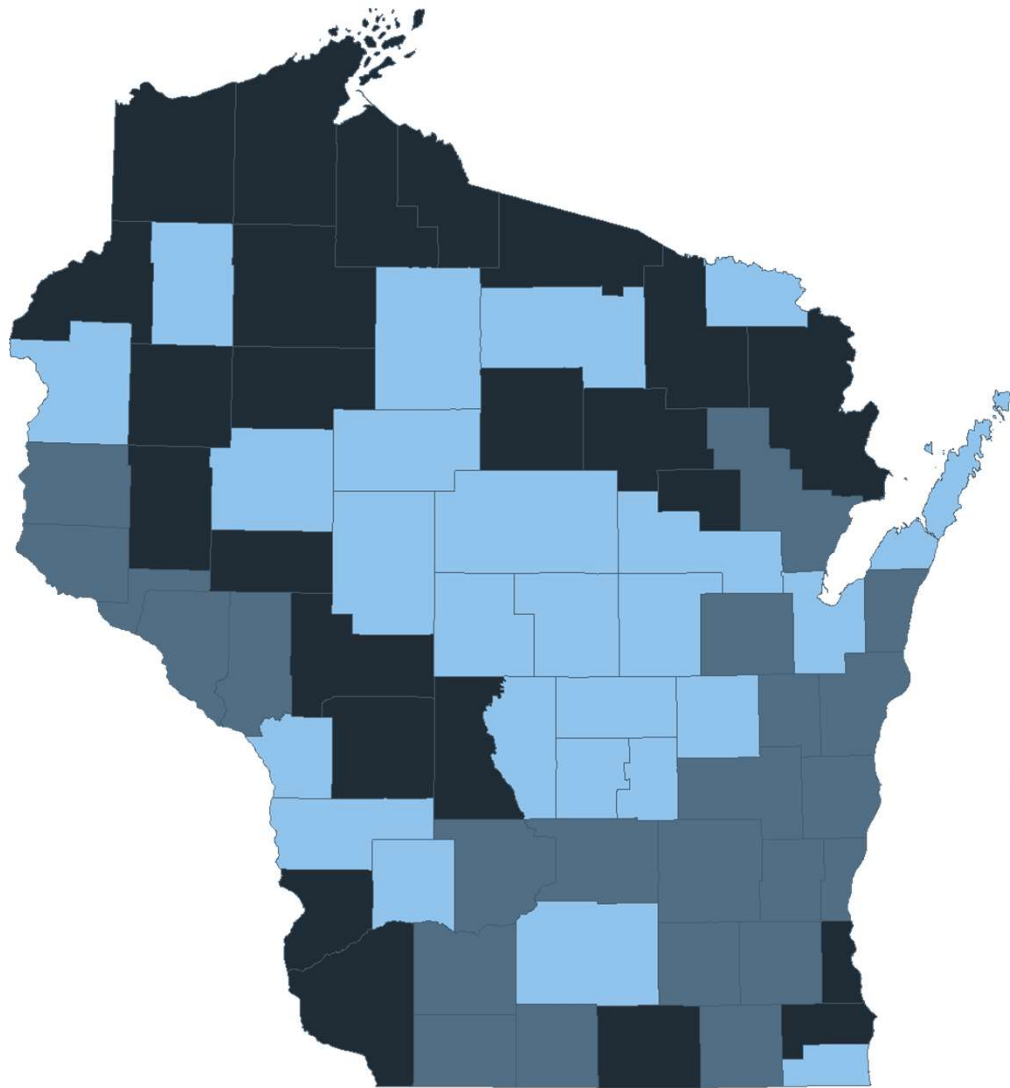

2013 Predicated Food Insecurity Rate – All Persons

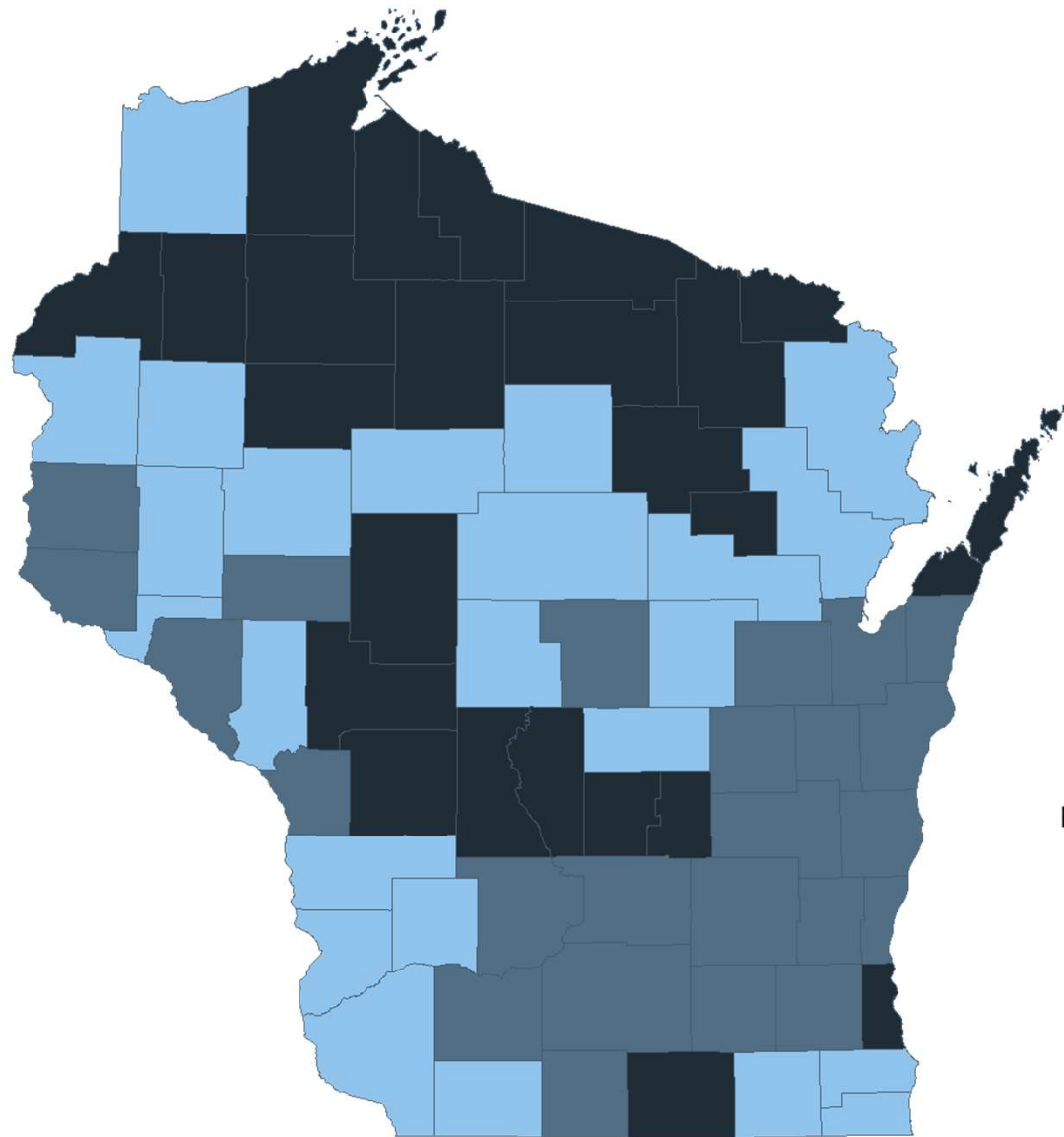

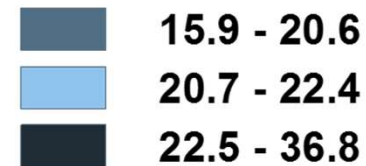


2013 Predicted Food Insecurity Rate - Children

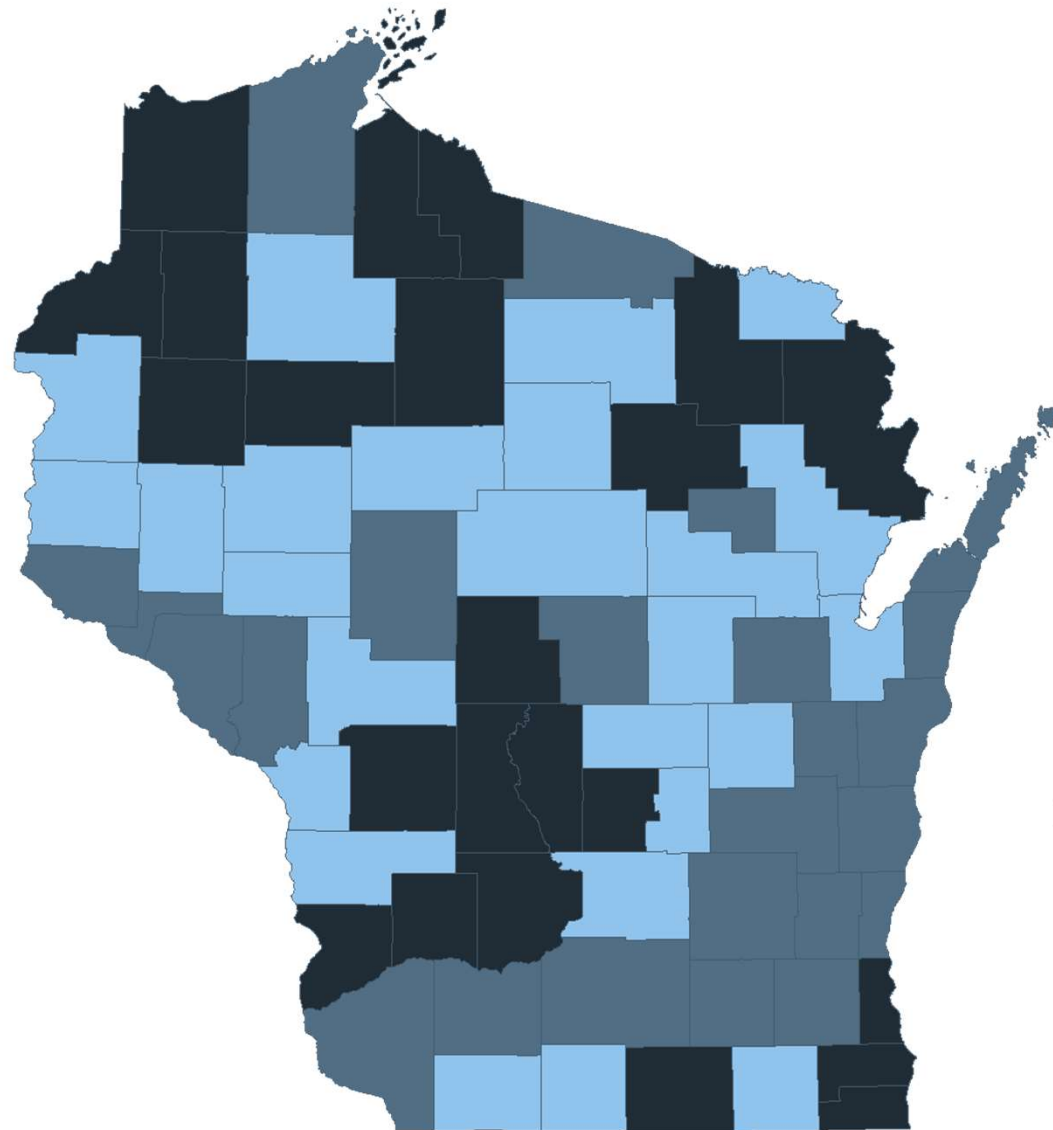

2013 FoodShare Participants: Percent of the Total Population

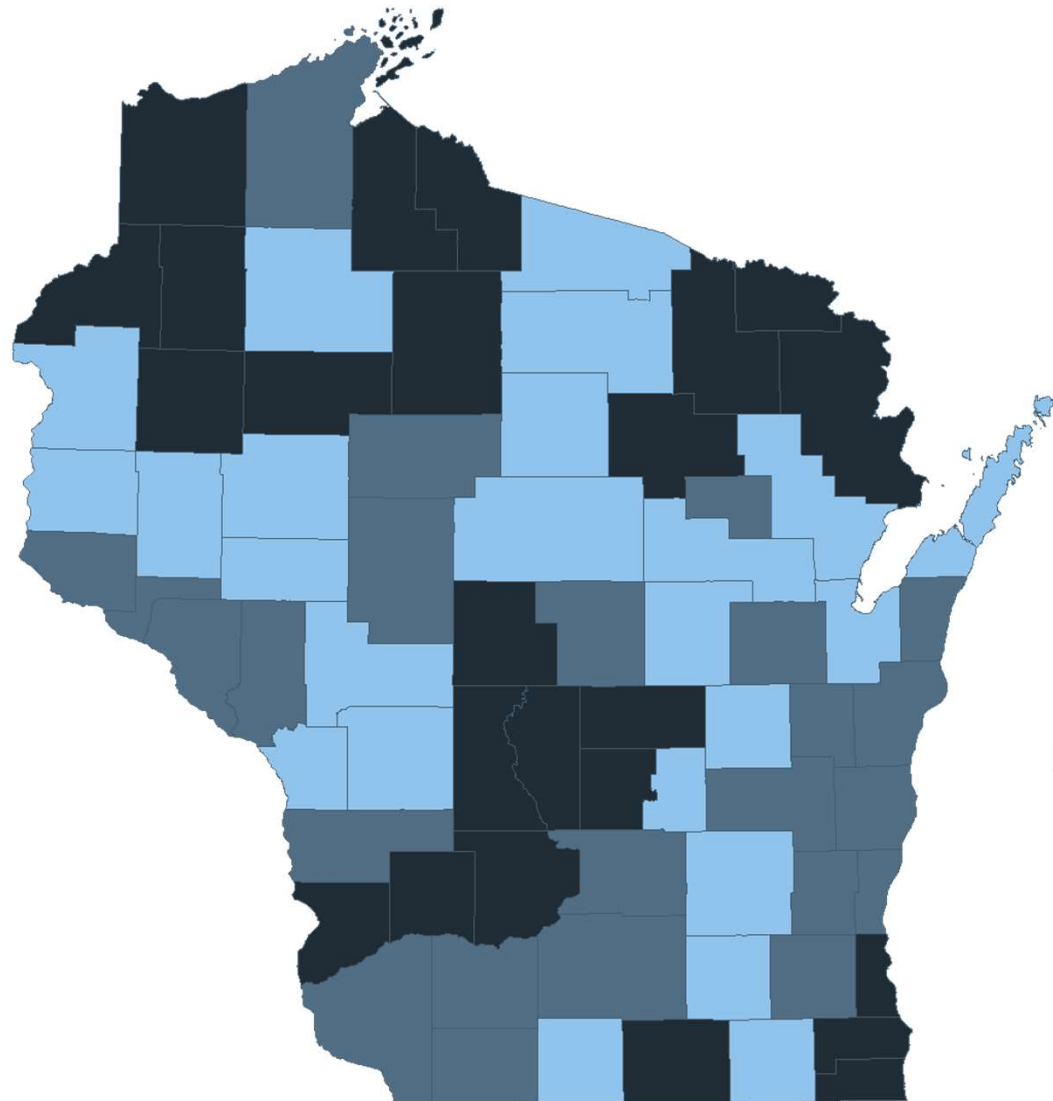
